The authors are fully responsible for the scientific content and originality of their submissions. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to edit or reject submissions that do not meet the academic standards, thematic relevance, or formatting requirements of the conference.

Articles must be formatted in the following order:

Article Formatting Requirements

Title: Centered, uppercase, bold

Authors: First name and patronymic (initials or full), followed by full surname, centered and bold

Affiliation: Full name of institution and country

Corresponding Author Email

Abstract: Up to 150 words, in English only

Keywords: Five keywords, in English only

Main Text: 2–5 pages

References: At the end, in alphabetical order

Formatting Details:

- Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx)
- Font: Times New Roman, size 12
- Line spacing: single (1.0)
- Paragraph indent: 1.25 cm
- Margins: Left – 3 cm, Right – 2 cm, Top/Bottom – 2.5 cm
- No page numbers
- Latin names and formulas in italics
- Maximum: 4 figures, 3 tables

In-text citation style:

One author: (Temirbekov, 2018)

Two authors: (Yesbergenov and Kurbanbayev, 2012)

More than two authors: (Yembergenov et al., 2020)

References: Maximum 10 sources.
